The Community Investment Tax (CIT) has facilitated the growth of Hillsborough County since it was passed in 1996. Any business or family that was established here in the last 28 years benefited from the CIT. Renewing the CIT will contribute to improving our transportation network and public safety services; two critical issues for Westshore and communities across Hillsborough County. It is just as important to recognize that this continued investment is necessary for economic development and an improved quality of life for residents.

Renewing the CIT would keep sales taxes at the same rate as the last 28 years, and leverage new projects to create a larger benefit for businesses and residents. Historically, visitors and tourists pay a significant amount of the sales tax, further making the case that renewing the CIT has a positive impact on our community.

The Westshore Alliance endorsed the original Community Investment Tax in 1996. The Westshore and Hillsborough County of today are a product of those investments made by the CIT in the last three decades.
